Open mic is at 8pm before the main act every 3rd Wednesday of the month.

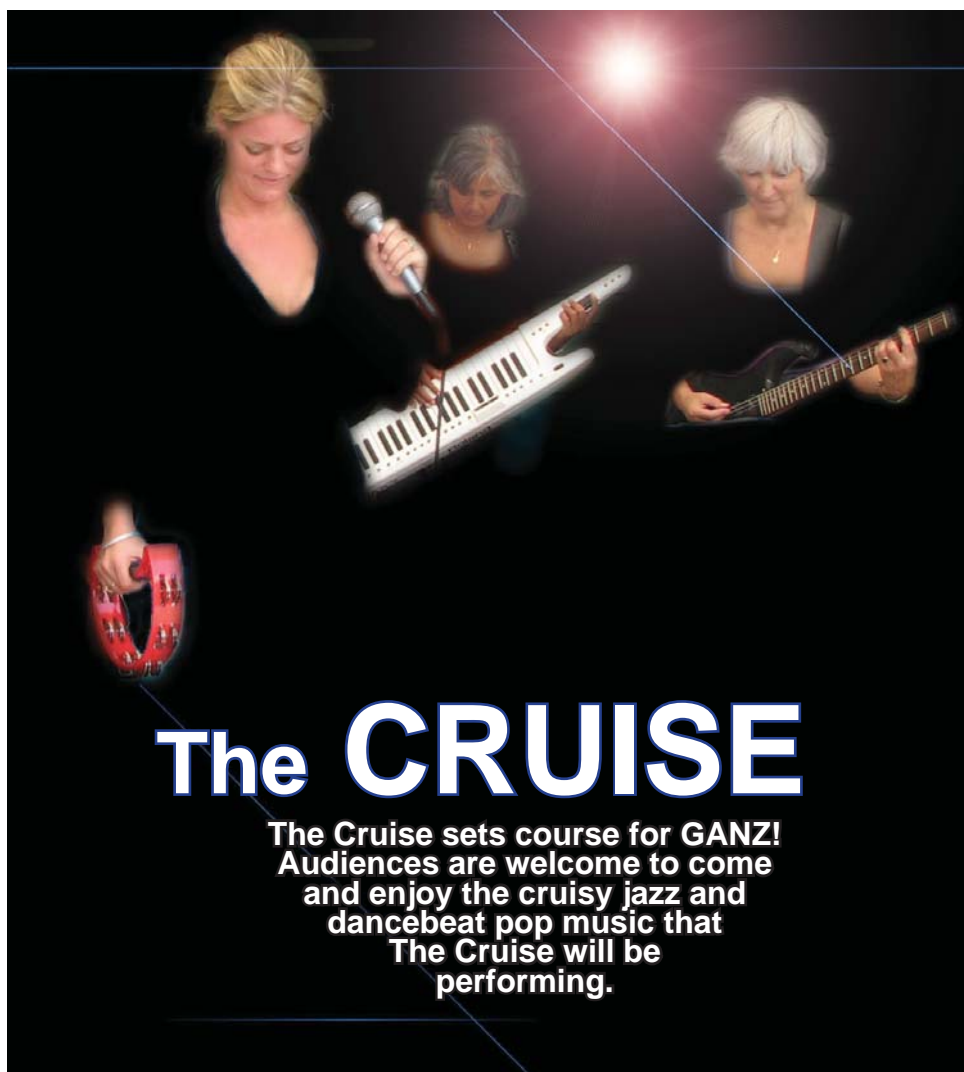
Time for you all to get up and play guitar. You are invited to put your name down and play.

THE FEATHERBONES TOUR DECEMBER 2010

Horizon Music NZ presents 2010 APRA award winner **Matt Langley** with support from Australian songwriter **Caitlin Harnett**.

Matt Langley will tour New Zealand this December to support the release of his debut LP 'Featherbones'. This follows Matt's critically acclaimed EP 'Lost Companions' and caps off a big year for Matt having recently been awarded the 2010 APRA country song of the year.

Supporting Matt will be Sydney-based songwriter Caitlin Harnett. Caitlin announced herself in 2009 as one of Australia's brightest young song writing talents. She released her first EP "Tiny Spark", signed to Mushroom Music Publishing, and had her music feature on a wide range of prime time television programs and films. Caitlin will be promoting the release of her new EP "All in the golden afternoon".
